## **Allen Corporation of America (Allen) Awarded Option Period Contract Modification to Continue FAA Aircraft Support.**

Allen's Training Systems Division was awarded a contract modification to continue to provide Piper Seminole PA 44 and Cessna Skyhawk CE 172 aircraft to the FAA Flight Standards Flight Program Division AFS-60. These aircraft will support AFS-60 mission to provide fixed-wing single and multi-engine training to FAA Aviation Safety Inspectors. To perform this contract Allen teamed with ATP which is headquartered in Jacksonville, FL. Under the FAA Aircraft Support Contract the Allen-ATP Team will provide the FAA PA44 and CE 172 to support approximately 10,000 hours of annual ASI training in each aircraft. The aircraft support is being provided at Alliance Airport in Fort Worth, Texas.
